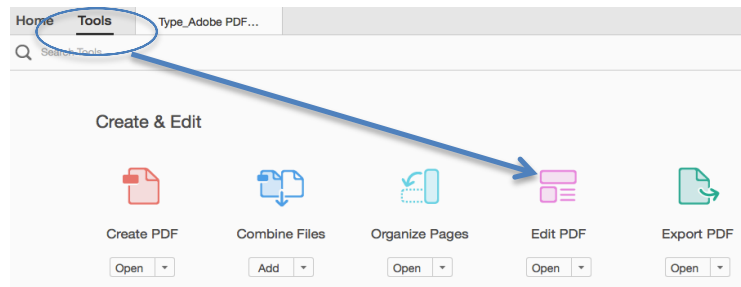


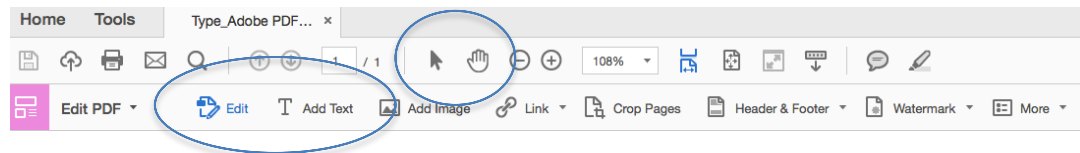
How to Type Anywhere on an Adobe PDF File

***Be sure that your files open in Adobe Acrobat.**

1. **Open a PDF file in Adobe Acrobat Pro** (see handout for converting to Adobe Pro from Preview if needed)
2. **Go to the toolbar across the top of the application, select *Tools*, & *Edit PDF*:**



3. **Select “Tools” and Open “Content Editing”**



- To type **ANYWHERE** on a document, select the **“Add Text”** icon & then click where you want to type (There will be a formatting tool that opens under the “add Text” area on the right-you can change the color of the font, size, and more.
- To Edit a Text Box, select **“Edit”** on the toolbar above.
- To get out of the Content Editing Tools, go to the toolbar across the top and select the **“cursor”** icon or the **“hand”** icon (circled above)
